


## Special Report - June 14, 2002

**Exciting News From Latvia:** The church in Jurmala has received government approval to construct a building. Two years ago the church was forced out of the public school building in which they had been meeting for several years and were subsequently denied permission to meet in any public facility. We purchased property for the church near the center of the city's residential district, however, at that time, the government denied permission to construct a building for the church. As a result, the church has been meeting in a greenhouse for the past two years.

**T**he Greenhouse Church: A greenhouse was situated on the property we purchased, and having been denied permission to meet in any public facility or to construct a building, the greenhouse became the home to the Jurmala church. Throughout the harsh Latvian winters, with temperatures often reaching  $-20^{\circ}$  F, the Christians have remained faithful in attendance and their commitment. Although the plastic greenhouse is extremely modest, the Spirit of the Lord is present and the services are powerful.

**The Need:** Members of the Latvian churches will join together to do most of the actual construction. Although the church members are sacrificially giving of their finances to help the Jurmala church, they don't have adequate money to purchase the materials which are estimated to cost \$33,000. The government has given only a limited window of time to construct the building. We are planning to start the foundation in the next two weeks. It is our desire to complete the outer shell before winter arrives.
