Ministry in Islamic countries has resulted in over one thousand new converts in addition to thousands of salvations in our other crusades is of particular note.

As usual, many of the memorable highlights have come from the more difficult and challenging ministry events:

- Dedication of the new church building in Jurmala, Latvia.
- Being chased by rioting pygmies in the Congo.

- Orphanage partnership with a fledgling children's home to provide economy of scale and better onsite administration and care for the children.
